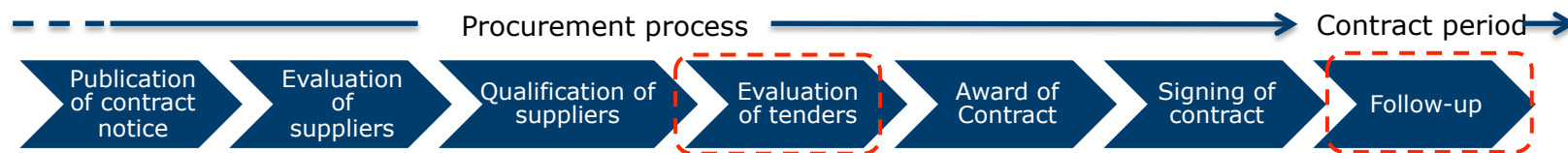

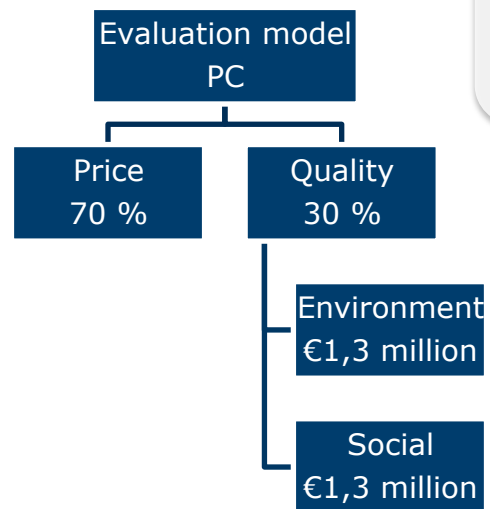
Contractual Obligations

- Goods and services shall be produced under conditions which are compatible with:
 - UN Declaration of Human Rights
 - ILO core conventions
 - UN Convention on Rights of the Child
 - Labour protection and labour environmental legislation in the country of production (inc ILO 155 and 170)
 - Labour laws
 - Environmental protection legislation
 - UN Convention on Corruption

Award Criteria

Our supplier should offer (product) from brand owners who can provide a list of the chemical products used in the final assembly of the quoted products.

Verification

- Alcohol
- Silica gel
- Grease
- Hydraulic oil
- Lube oil

- A description of whether the brand owners work for employers to inform and obtain the consent of employees when they work with toxic substances in the supply chain for products delivered under the agreement and how the brand owners work to ensure that handling and use of these substances does not cause harm to people and the environment.



Answers

- Manufacturing Process Chemicals Program
- RBA
- Clean Electronics Production Network
- Training (but not clear on what)
- Monitoring and mitigating
- H&S 41% of non-compliances
- NO ONE described that they obtain informed consent.
